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### INFORMATION FOR BAKERS

If you are donating baked goods for the cake stall – THANK YOU! We do need to ask you to please work within the following requirements.

- We need all food to be shelf stable. This means NO cream or custard or something that requires refrigeration or heating to stay safe to eat.
- We also need all food to be covered or packaged in plastic such as glad wrap or plastic bags and on, or in, disposable / recyclable materials.
  - Where possible, it would be great if the packaging can be nicely presented with ribbon, string etc.
  - Some packaging ideas might include disposable plates, cellophane bags, cellophane wrap, plastic bags, plastic containers, cling wrap.
  - We do not have an option to package items for you on the day, so they need to come already packaged and labelled as below.
- Each item needs to be clearly labelled to show:
  - Name / description of what it is
  - Date baked / prepared
  - List of ingredients
  - Allergens MUST be clearly identified (this must include Gluten, Egg, Nuts, Milk, Soy, Coconut, Sesame, etc.)
  - Suggested price, or we can do this for you. We have price stickers you can use. Contact Liz: [lturner2017@gmail.com](mailto:lturner2017@gmail.com) if you'd like an indicative price list.

Please remember to use good hygiene and ensure that you have clean hands (washed with soap) prior to handling any food or completing any baking.
