<b>Ignite Taster Day</b>	Tuesday 5th April (Term 1, Week 10)	Come and “Ignite” your love for Electives! An introduction to the Ignite Elective Package offered at CCS. Students participate in a range of Ignite Electives including Cooking & Hospitality, Digital Photography, Visual Arts, Drama, Woodwork, Outdoor Education and 3D Animation.
<b>Open Night</b>	Wednesday 18 <sup>th</sup> May (Term 2, Week 4)	The CCS Open night is the ultimate showcase of learning and achievement. Come and feel the positive vibe at CCS. Experience Science experiments, technology displays, watch a range of student performances in Dance and Drama and enjoy the service of our Year 9 and 10 Hospitality students hard at work in the Café. The evening will also include Ignite Selective Program information sessions, displays of student artwork, Dance, Music and Drama performances, Year 6, 7 and 8 camp displays, Outdoor Education displays, open classrooms and facilities and, most importantly, a chance to talk with staff and students about what makes CCS a great place to learn.
<b>Year 6 Sport Expo</b>	13 <sup>th</sup> September (Term 3, Week 9)	A two-hour sports round robin hosted by our Student Leadership Team, where we mix it up and start to get to know the other students from the Chisholm Cluster. Students will experience a range of different physical challenges, while learning about how CCS encourages the development of students as active, lifelong participants of physical activity and sport. In addition, students will learn about the amazing House System at CCS and how we reward and encourage the development of the whole child.
<b>Middle Years Mash-Up</b>	11 <sup>th</sup> November (Term 4, Week 5)	By now students know which high school they’re attending, so this is a special event for all the kids who will be joining us at CCS in 2017. The day aims to start developing the relationships between students from different schools and continue the development of connections with CCS that started throughout the previous events through the Transition Program.
