Dear Parents/Carers,

This year's swimming carnival will be held at the Canberra Indoor Swimming and Aquatic Centre (CISAC), Thursday, 28 February 2019 (week 4). The swimming carnival is open for all students 8 years of age and older, and will consist of a competitive swimming competition, followed by water play activities. Students in Year 2 who are turning 8 this year are invited to attend, provided they are entered in one or more of the races. To swim in the competitive swimming races, students will need to be nominated by their parents/carers on the return permission slip. (Note: Kindergarten to Year 2 students, under the age of 8 years of age will participate in water play activities at school.)

Venue: Canberra Indoor Swimming and Aquatic Centre (CISAC)

Transport: Q-City

What to Bring: Swimmers (goggles, cap, etc. if required), dry clothes, towel, drink bottle, lunch and recess
(canteen facilities will be open)

Cost: \$14.00
