Enrolments

Preschool Language and Gross Motor Program – Term 3

This term a Speech Language Pathologist, Occupational Therapist and Allied Health Assistants (AHA) from the ACT Education Directorate will be visiting the Gowrie Preschool in order to support the school to run a group program supporting the children's development. The Allied Health team will be working alongside the teachers during a weekly group. The group aims to:

- Develop phonological awareness including segmenting sounds, identifying first and last sounds and blending.
- Develop gross motor skills including throwing and catching, jumping, balance and core strength
- Develop resilience and increase independence

Preschool students nominated have received a parent information note outlining the program.

Senior and Early Years STEM Enrichment Programs

Students from Gowrie Primary School have been nominated to participate in a range of STEM related team challenges. The Senior Program will involve team challenges including a rocket challenge, math murder mystery, glider challenge and science experiments. These will be held at Erindale College.

The Early Years STEM Program will provide the students from P – Yr 2 the opportunity to explore and investigate through Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics some of the key understandings of Forces and Motion. Children will be given an opportunity to solve a problem by creating a Rube Goldberg machine. The workshop will be very hands on and interactive, providing children with the chance to extend their abilities. This program will be held at the Caroline Chisholm School – Centre for Innovation and Learning located on the Senior Campus. Information regarding these programs will be sent home today.

K – Yr 2 Swim School

We are excited to give the students the opportunity to acquire essential life skills in water safety and survival through the Royal Life Saving ACT.

The Royal Life Saving ACT *Swim & Survive* program – is a series of 5 x 1 hour sessions which will provide every participating student the opportunity to access structured aquatic activities during school time. The program will be held at Active Leisure Centre, Erindale. Registration and payment is available online. Parents will receive notes and information this week. We encourage ALL students to attend this worthwhile program. If you are experiencing financial difficulty please contact the principal.

Insurance and Ambulance Transport

The ACT Education Directorate does not provide any insurance cover for injury, disease or illness to students resulting from school activities or school-organised excursions. Claims for compensation are met where there is a legal liability to do so. Liability is not automatic and depends on the circumstances in which any injury, disease or illness was sustained.

As there is no automatic insurance cover for personal injury if your child is injured at school or during a school organised activity/excursion you should therefore consider whether taking out personal insurance cover for your child is warranted.

This insurance might cover contingencies including medical/hospital expenses, ambulance transport outside the ACT, and cancellation of transport/accommodation or loss of/damage to luggage.

The ACT Ambulance Service provides free ambulance transport for students who are injured or suddenly become ill at school or during an approved school organised activity **within the ACT**.

Student Tested Recipes to try at home. Can you make yours as good as the Gowrie students have??

Fresh Salad



Ingredients

3 large tomatoes
2 cucumber
1 avocado
2 large ear of corn
Handful fresh parsley
Handful baby spinach
Optional: red onion
Lemon juice

Directions

1. Boil the corn for 5 minutes.
 2. When cooked (cooled), carefully cut kernels off the cob.
 3. Dice cucumber and avocado, and halve tomatoes. Add to a bowl with the corn.
 4. Roughly chop your parsley and add to bowl.
 5. Add the zest of 1 lemon
 6. Add 1 handful of baby spinach
 7. Add 1/2 lemon juice
- Lightly toss to combine.

Garlic, parmesan, zucchini fritters



INGREDIENTS LIST FOR THE ZUCCHINI FRITTERS

- 2 cups shredded zucchini
- 2 cups shredded carrots
- 2 cloves garlic, grated
- 2/3 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup grated parmesan
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1/3 cup sliced spring onions (green and white parts)
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- Sour cream or greek yogurt, for serving

1. Place shredded zucchini in a colander and sprinkle with a pinch of salt. Squeeze out as much liquid as possible with your hands. This will prevent the fritters from getting soggy while cooking.
2. Put drained zucchini into a large bowl then add the carrots, garlic, flour, eggs, spring onions, salt and pepper. Stir the mixture until combined.
3. Line a plate or tray with paper towels. Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat and add the olive oil. Scoop mounds of the vegetable mixture into the pan, flattening the slightly and spacing them evenly into the pan. Proceed in batch to avoid overcrowding the pan.
4. Cook the fritters for 2 to 3 minutes then flip on the other side and continue cooking for 1 to 2 minutes more, until they're golden brown and crispy. Transfer to the paper towel-lined plate, season with salt and repeat the process with the remaining mixture.
5. Serve the fritters immediately topped with sour cream or greek yogurt. Enjoy!
